Our safari experience is priced at R25200 per person sharing. Single Supplement R12800. Please note that any bank charges incurred during the payment process are not covered by Tusk Photo. We kindly request the full amount indicated on the invoice, including any fees imposed by Paypal if you choose to use this payment method.

Deposit:

To secure your reservation, a 50% deposit of the full price is required within 14 days of making your booking. Once we receive your deposit, your booking will be confirmed. Please make sure to complete this step within the given timeframe to secure your spot.

Balance:

The remaining balance is due at least 9 weeks prior to the safari. If you are making a booking within 9 weeks of the safari, the full price will be payable at the time of booking.

Cancellation Policy:

We understand that plans can change, and in the event of a cancellation, the following fees will apply unless Tusk Photo is able to fill your safari space:

- Cancellation more than 120 days prior to departure: 10% of the full price

Flights and Transport

There are various options to get to Elephant Plains:

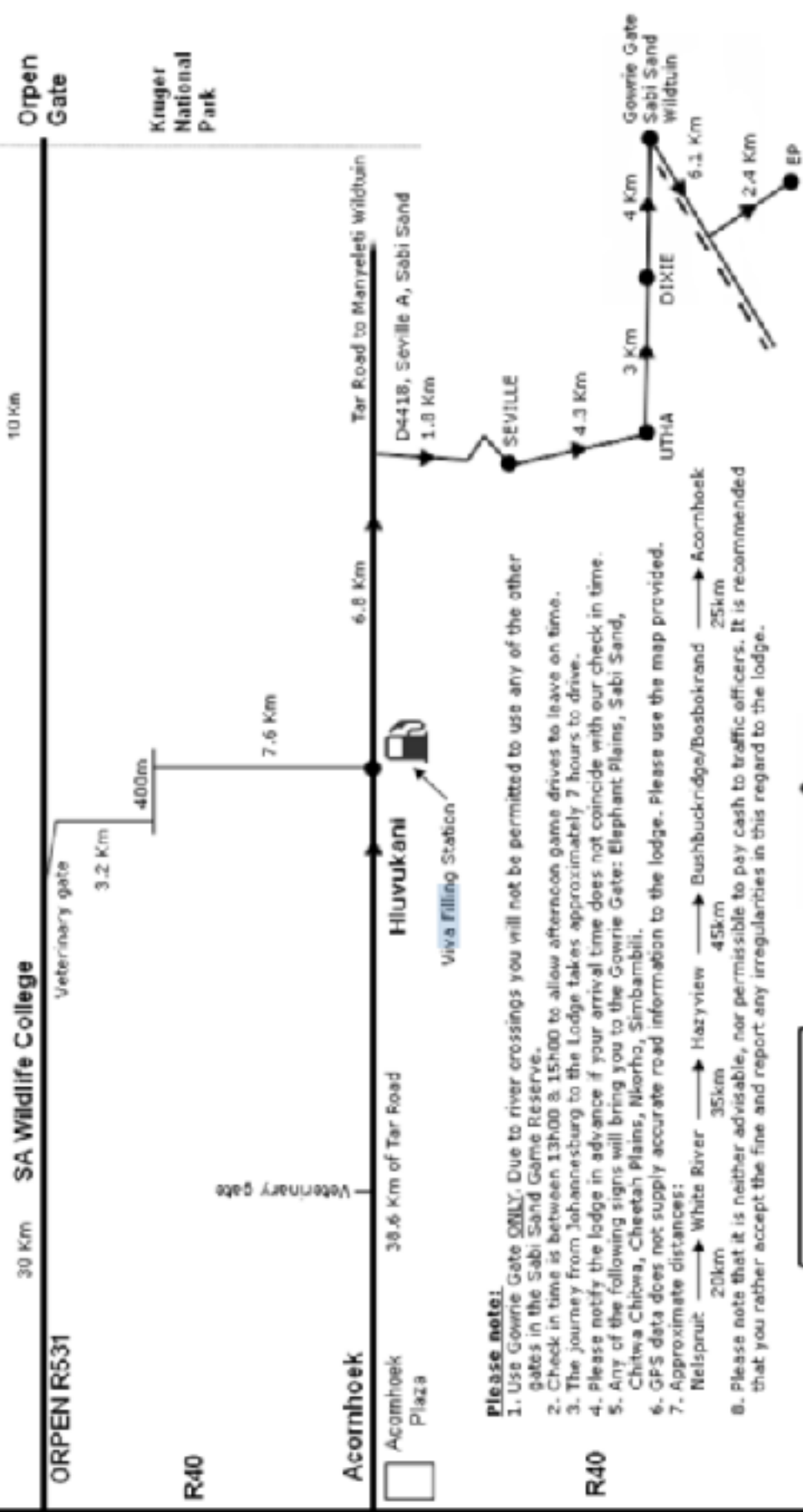
- Option 1 – You can self-drive to the lodge. From Johannesburg its a 7hr journey on tar road with the last +-60km on dirt road
- Option 2 – You can fly into the Sabi Sand with either Federal Air (Charter company) or SA Airlink (Commercial Service)
- Option 3 – You can fly to either Hoedspruit or Nelspruit (KMIA) and arrange transfers or car hire (Car hire for own arrangements) from there to the lodge
- Option 4 – You can arrange a transfer from Gauteng / Johannesburg to the lodge and back again.
- Private charter or own flight into Elephant Plains airstrip.

Please note that there is a R310 per vehicle and R180 per person entrance fee into the Sabi Sands conservancy. (Subject to change)

Please note:

1. Use Gowie Gate ONLY. Due to river crossings you will not be permitted to use any of the other gates in the Sabi Sand Game Reserve.
2. Check in time is between 13h00 & 15h00 to allow afternoon game drives to leave on time.
3. The journey from Johannesburg to the Lodge takes approximately 7 hours to drive.
4. Please notify the lodge in advance if your arrival time does not coincide with our check in time.
5. Any of the following signs will bring you to the Gowie Gate: Elephant Plains, Sabi Sand, Chitwa Chitwa, Cheetah Plains, Nkorha, Simbambili.
6. GPS data does not supply accurate road information to the lodge. Please use the map provided.
7. Approximate distances:
Nelspruit → White River → 20km
White River → Hazzyview → 35km
Hazzyview → Bushbuckridge/Bosbokrand → 45km
Bushbuckridge/Bosbokrand → Acomrhoek → 25km
8. Please note that it is neither advisable, nor permissible to pay cash to traffic officers. It is recommended that you rather accept the fine and report any irregularities in this regard to the lodge.

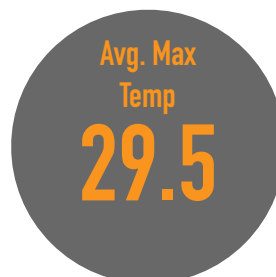
Electricity are provided and plugs and sockets will be type N and type C.



CLIMATE

Sabi Sands experiences moderate and favorable weather throughout the year, making it an excellent destination to immerse yourself in nature's beauty. Here's a brief overview of the seasons:

- Summer (Dec-Feb): Warm and vibrant with abundant sunshine (25-35°C/77-95°F). Nourishing rains create a lush green paradise, accompanied by brief but dramatic showers and thunderstorms. Pleasant evenings offer outdoor activities and serene African night sounds.
- Autumn (Mar-May): Mild temperatures and dwindling rainfall. Ample sunshine (20-30°C/68-86°F) paints the foliage in mesmerizing red and gold hues. Enjoy cozy campfire gatherings beneath the starlit African sky during cool evenings.
- Winter (Jun-Aug): Mild and dry climate ideal for wildlife viewing. Warm days (20-25°C/68-77°F) with occasional chilly mornings and evenings (around 5°C/41°F). The savanna unveils its essence as the grass recedes, facilitating wildlife spotting. Clear skies allow for stargazing and captivating celestial vistas.
- Spring (Sep-Nov): The land awakens with rising temperatures (25-30°C/77-86°F). Colorful blossoms burst forth, adorning the savanna with vibrant splashes of pink, yellow, and purple. Wildlife activity peaks, offering opportunities to witness newborn animals exploring their surroundings.



CLOTHING AND WHAT TO PACK

For your comfort during safari, we recommend packing comfortable, casual clothes that are easy to wash and wear. Opt for muted colors for game-viewing, and keep in mind that early morning and late afternoon game drives can be chilly, especially in winter. Essential items to pack include

- khaki, green, beige, and neutral-colored clothing,
- shirts with long sleeves for sun and mosquito protection,
- T-shirts,
- shorts or a light skirt,
- jeans or safari trousers
- a jacket or sweater for cooler moments,
- comfortable walking shoes and sandals,
- sun protection items like sunscreen, sunglasses, a hat,
- insect repellent,
- moisturizer,
- and lip balm.
